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Instructions

Part 1: Importer

For **section A**, enter the name of the company or person responsible for importing the product(s).
 For **section B**, enter the nine-digit business number assigned to the company by the Minister of National Revenue.
 For **sections C, D, E and F**, enter the importer's contact information.

Part 2: Imported Products Information

For the make, model, unique identification number, model year, and family, look at the engine or machine label, or contact the manufacturer.

Manufacturer: the company that manufactured the engine or machine.

Make: the brand of the engine or machine, this may be the same as the manufacturer or a different brand.

Model: the commercial name given by the manufacturer to identify the product.

Unique Identification Number: a number, consisting of Arabic numerals, Roman letters or both, that the manufacturer assigns to the engine for identification purposes (i.e. engine serial number).

Model year: the year used by the manufacturer to designate the time of production.

Family: a 12 digit alphanumeric code that a manufacturer uses for vehicles or engines when applying for certification with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. It is a group of engines that are expected to have similar emission characteristics.

- **Exhaust Family:** for exhaust emissions, engines are grouped into families by taking into consideration aspects such as their combustion cycle, fuel, method of aspiration, presence and characteristics of catalytic converters, bore and stroke, etc.
- **Evaporative Family:** for evaporative emissions, engines are grouped into families taking into consideration the characteristics of the fuel system components such as material, material additives, production methods, etc.

Machine

If the engine is installed in or on a machine at the time of importation, enter the information in both the "Engine" and "Machine" sections.

Replacement Engine

If the engine is not installed in or on a machine at the time of importation, enter the information in the "Engine" section. Do not enter anything in the "Machine" section.

Type

For each engine, specify the engine **Type** as one of the following.

- MCI: Mobile Compression Ignition,
- SCI: Stationary Compression Ignition, or
- LSI: Large Spark Ignition.

Compliance Statement Numbers

For each engine, select one of the following statements.

- Statement 1: The engine is a replacement engine and the engine it will replace has been identified.
- Statement 2: The engine is a replacement engine and the engine it will replace will only be identified after importation.

Alternative Emission Standard

If the engine is of **Type** "MCI" or "SCI" specify if the engine conforms to an alternative emission standard from one of the following options.

- Statement N/A: The engine does not conform to an alternative emission standard.
- Statement 1: The Compression-ignition engine that powers an emergency machine.
- Statement 2: The Compression-ignition engine that is or will be installed in a machine to be used only in a hazardous location where the maximum permissible surface temperature for the machine is 200°C or less.
- Statement 3: The Mobile compression-ignition engine that is to be used exclusively to provide a primary source of electrical power in a remote location.
- Statement 4: The Mobile compression-ignition engine that is to be used exclusively at a North Warning System site established by the North American Aerospace Defense Command.
- Statement 5: The Mobile compression-ignition engine that is used in a transportation refrigeration unit.
- Statement 6: The Stationary compression-ignition engine that is intended to provide electrical power or mechanical work during a power outage.
- Statement 7: The Stationary compression-ignition engine that is a fire-pump engine.
- Statement 8: The Stationary compression-ignition engine that is to be used in a remote location.

Evidence of Conformity: The engine to be replaced has been identified.

The "**Evidence of Conformity:** The engine to be replaced has been identified." section applies for engines declared under **Compliance Statement Number 1**.

Evidence of Conformity Statement

For each engine, select one of statements 1 or 2.

- Statement 1: The Importer is able to provide the required evidence of conformity.
- Statement 2: The Importer has provided the required evidence of conformity to Environment and Climate Change Canada.

Evidence of Conformity Location

For each engine, select one of statements 1 to 3.

- Statement 1: The required evidence of conformity is retained at the place of business of the importer provided in Part 1 section E.
- Statement 2: The required evidence of conformity is retained at a place of business of the importer other than the place of business provided in Part 1 section E.
- Statement 3: The required evidence of conformity is retained at a location other than a place of business of the importer.

Street Address / Mailing Address (if different from street address)

For each engine where Evidence of Conformity Location is

- Statement 1:
 - Disregard the **Street Address** and **Mailing Address (if different from street address)** fields.
- Statement 2:
 - In the **Street Address** field, use the alphabetic characters (i.e. A, B, C) in *Part 3: Address* table to reference the street address where evidence of conformity is retained.
- Statement 3:
 - In the **Street Address** field, use the alphabetic characters (i.e. A, B, C) in *Part 3: Address* table to reference the street address where evidence of conformity is retained.
 - In the **Mailing Address (if different from street address)** field, use the alphabetic characters (i.e. A, B, C) in *Part 3: Address* table to reference the mailing address where evidence of conformity is retained (if different from the street address).
 - In the **Contact Name** and **Contact Phone Number** fields, provide the name and telephone number of a contact person at the location where evidence of conformity is retained.

Evidence of Conformity: The engine to be replaced will only be identified after importation.

The "**Evidence of Conformity:** The engine to be replaced will only be identified after importation." section applies for engines declared under **Compliance Statement Number 2**.

Engine Location

The address of the location where the engine will be kept until the evidence of conformity referred to in subsection 41(1) has been submitted to Environment and Climate Change Canada must be provided. For each engine, select one of the following statements.

- Statement 1: The engine will be kept at the place of business of the importer provided in Part 1 section E.
- Statement 2: The engine will be kept at a location other than the place of business of the importer provided in Part 1 section E.

Address

For each engine where **Engine Location** is

- Statement 1:
 - Disregard the **Street Address** field.
- Statement 2:
 - In the **Address** field, use the alphabetic characters (i.e. A, B, C) in *Part 3: Address* table to reference the address where engine will be kept until the evidence of conformity referred to in subsection 41(1) is submitted to Environment and Climate Change Canada.

Description of Measures

Provide a description of the measures that will be taken to ensure that the engine does not leave the company's possession or control before the evidence of conformity referred to in subsection 41(1) is submitted to Environment and Climate Change Canada.

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Instructions — continued

Part 3: Address

The alphabetic characters listed in the *Part 3: Address* table (e.g. "A", "B") are intended to be used to reference addresses that may be required in the *Part 2: Imported Products Information* table. The *Part 3: Address* table should allow for enough space such that all address details can be included, should they be required. Please see the following example for a better understanding.

Evidence of Conformity Example

- The alphabetic character "A" in the *Part 3: Address* table references the **Street Address** field in the *Part 2: Imported Products Information* table.
- The alphabetic character "B" in the *Part 3: Address* table references the **Mailing Address (if different from street address)** field in the *Part 2: Imported Products Information* table.
- The alphabetic character "C" in the *Part 3: Address* table references the **Address** field in the *Part 2: Imported Products Information* table.
